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33rd Annual Beeline Cruise-In Classic Car Show to be held in Payson, AZ, Oct 10, 2026

The Beeline Cruisers Motor Club (BCMC) will hold its annual classic car show on Saturday, Oct. 10, 2026 from 8 am to 3pm at Payson's Green Valley Park, 600 S Green Valley Pkwy. One of the most popular events held annually in Payson, the show features cars, trucks, lowriders and rat rods aged 25 years and older. Awards are given for Best of Show as well as 'Best of' awards in several other categories.

Pre-Car Show activities will begin on Friday, Oct. 9, with an approximately 1-hour classic car cruise through central Payson as well as a barbeque at Rumsey Park for car show registrants and club members. The car cruise will begin at 3:30 pm at Rumsey Park, 400 N McLane Rd, and will feature a variety of vehicles aged 25+ years driving along the cruise route for the public's enjoyment. A special slow-drive loop through the parking lot of the Majestic Rim senior living facility will be included so residents can get a closer look at the vehicles.

The car show is free to the General Public. Town of Payson will be assisting with food trucks and vendor booths, entertainment, etc. Owners of cars, trucks, low riders and rat rods from Model Year 2001 or older are encouraged to participate. Car show exhibitor spaces typically fill quickly so early registration prior to Oct. 7 is advised.
